

PROVISION FOR AWARDING GRACE MARK IN THE HSSLC & HSLC
EXAMINATIONS UNDER MBSE

1. A Tabulator can add up to 2(two) marks in a particular subject to make a candidate pass in that subject.

2. Up to 4 (four) marks can be awarded in the additional subject to make the candidate pass in the subject.

3. Grace marks of up to 12 (twelve) marks can be awarded in the following cases :

(a) If a candidate fails in one subject, then grace mark(s) can be added to make the score 33 % e.g., $22 + 4 = 26$, $14 + 12 = 26$, etc. in the case of 80 full mark.

(b) If a candidate fails in two subjects, then the grace marks can be distributed between the two subjects to make their scores 33 % respectively e.g., $23 + 3 = 26$ and $17 + 9 = 26$ and $18 + 8 = 26$, etc. in the case of 80 full mark.
