ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS AND SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

1. Eligibility for admission to D.El.Ed. Course

- a. Qualifications
 - i. Candidates with at least 50% marks in the Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination or any other name known.
 - ii. Relaxation up to 5% in the qualifying marks shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to reserved categories such as SC/ST/OBC/Differently abled.
 - iii. Candidates who do not possess the above qualifications shall not be eligible for admission to the D.El.Ed. Course.

2. Eligibility for admission to D.El.Ed. Examination

- a. A candidate appearing for D.El.Ed. Examination shall possess a registration card issued by the Mizoram Board of School Education.
- b. A candidate must have at least 80% of the total attendance of the semester counting from the day of teaching of each semester as the case may be up to the last teaching day of the semester.

3. Pass/Fail Criteria for D.El.Ed

- a. A candidate shall be declared pass when he/she secures not less than 40% marks separately in the external examination, internal assessment, and practical examinations, wherever applicable.
- b. A candidate who secures less than 40% of the total marks shall be declared failed.
- c. There shall be no division-wise pass classification.

4. Promotion Criteria

- a. A candidate who fails in not more than two (2) theory papers in a semester shall be eligible to carry the failed paper(s) as back paper(s) and be promoted to the next semester.
- b. A candidate has 2 (two) chances to clear his/her back papers of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semester within the time period allowed by NCTE.
- c. If a student fails in internal paper, he/she would not be permitted to take admission in the next semester.
- d. A candidate must clear all papers within a maximum of three (3) years from the date of admission to the programme.

5. Re-appearance

A candidate shall have two (2) chances for clearing back paper(s).

6. Improvement of Performance

- a. A candidate desirous to improve his/her performance in any course(s) of any semester shall be eligible to appear in the examinations of improvement after qualifying the examinations of all the four semesters.
- b. Eligibility under this category of partial improvement shall be subject to a maximum of three (3) courses to be opted by a candidate from among all four semesters. A candidate may opt one or more courses from either a particular semester from among different semesters subject to the maximum of three courses of either one or more semesters.

7. Relaxation of Attendance

Relaxation in attendance up to 50% may be granted to candidates with disabilities who are unable to attend classes for the prescribed number of days, provided that they submit a supporting certificate issued by an authorized competent Medical Authority.
